

Drafting and Sewing a Five Pointed Star

- For a 4 ½" finished (and embellished) star, chalk three circles measuring 4 ½", 2 ¼" and 2" using my Circleliner tool.
- Divide circles into 10 segments using my PentaLiner tool.




Simple 5-Pointed Star:

- Chalk 4 ½" and
 2" Circles.
- Start here (in red) and sew clockwise around circle as shown.



Embellished 5-Pointed Star:

- Follow directions above for simple star.
- one more time, adding dimensional lines as shown.



- Starting in the star center, follow numbered sequence to add shading inside star.
- If you would like to add feathers to the outside edge of circle as shown, start at the same spot as before, but go counterclockwise to fill.
