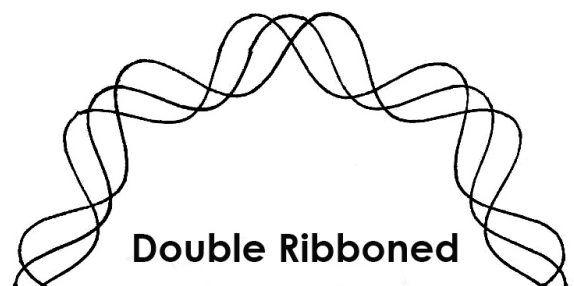
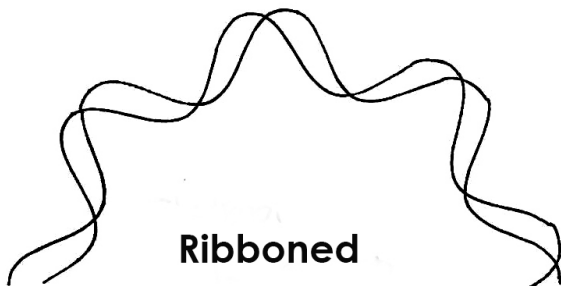
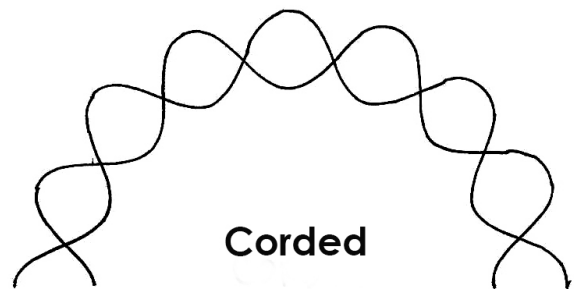
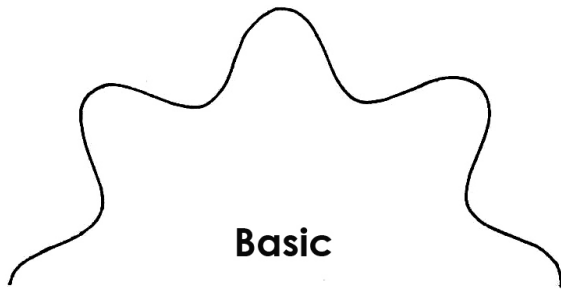


The In Cahoots Tidal Wave Set includes six rulers. Each ruler is labeled as the finished size circle it creates: 4", 4.5", 6", 6.5", 8" 8.5."

Here are the shapes the Tidal Wave rulers create. To save on space for illustrations, shapes will be shown in half-circles. Of course, full circle sew-outs are just as easy as half-circles!



Basic

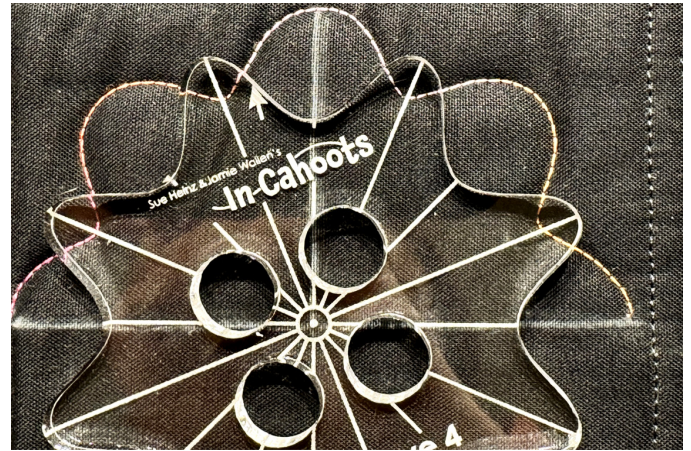


1. Mark centered vertical and horizontal alignment lines, as shown.
2. Choose the appropriately sized ruler (In this example, we're using the 4"), and align the ruler in the center of your marks, and along the vertical and horizontal lines.
3. Carefully sew, using the center holes (as needed) for finger grip.

Corded

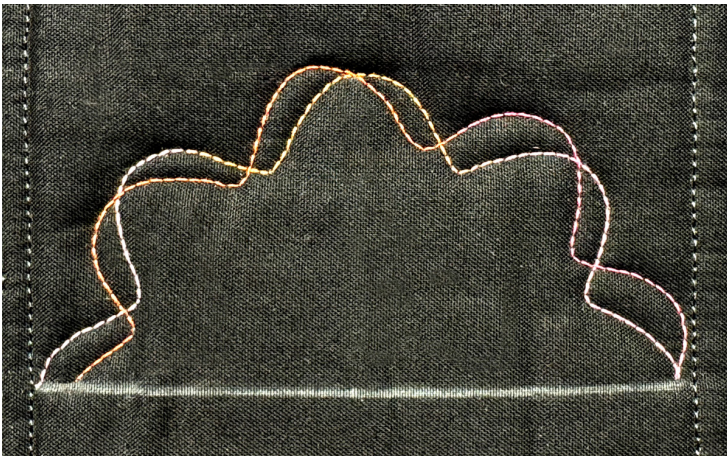


1. Sew the basic shape. 2. Rotate the ruler and align the ruler's solid white line in the valley of a previously sewn line, and sew.



Ruler position for a corded shape once the basic shape is sewn.

Ribboned

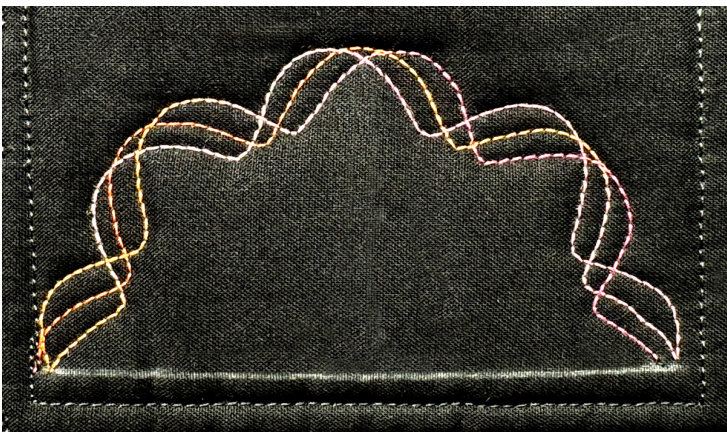


1. Sew the basic shape. 2. Rotate the ruler so that the arrow on the ruler aligns with the vertical line, and sew.



Ruler position for a ribboned shape once the basic shape has been sewn.

Double Ribboned



1. Follow the ribboned instructions above.



2. Once the ribboned shape is sewn, turn the ruler over, realign the arrow to the center, and sew.



Stems, (as shown in this feathered wreath), can be made by sewing two basic shapes in different sizes, using the same center horizontal and vertical marks.

This example used a 4" and a 4.5" Tidal Wave ruler. Free-motion feathers were added to the stem to create the wreath.



Here are just a few examples of border ideas using just one ruler size in each. Imagine what you can come up with when combining two (or more) ruler sizes, to create unique mandalas, blocks and borders!
